Who Should Attend?

This qualification has been developed in conjunction with the HSE (Health & Safety Executive) and is for managers, supervisors, safety representatives and safety champions, as well as those aspiring to step into these roles, who want to carry out effective incident investigations.

What Is Covered?

The course comprises the following key elements:-

- Moral, legal and financial arguments for investigations
- Human and organisational factors that can contribute to an incident
- The process for investigating incidents
- Positive interview strategies and the barriers to successful interviews

Attending the course, delegates will be able to:-

- Independently investigate simple incidents
- Gather evidence including conducting witness interviews
- Produce an action plan to prevent a recurrence of an incident
- Contribute to team investigations for large scale incidents
- Positively impact the safety culture in their organisation

How is it Assessed?

A practical assessment comprising a review of video interviews, collation of evidence and an action plan is undertaken during the course.
